

Wildlife Rehabber's Collage

Training & Education for Wildlife Rehabbers

Objective: Source of training and education for Wildlife Rehabbers, potential Wildlife Rehabbers and volunteers. Offering practical hands on training courses on basic Wildlife Rehabbing. Courses on 1) individual species and 2) how to run a wildlife Rehabbing operation.

Method: Most courses would be webinars (Zoom) run by experienced Rehabbers . Instructors would be compensated for their work. Most courses would be one day (6 to 8 hours) . There would be a test or exam at the end . Hand out material would be supplied in advance of the courses. Certificates would be sent to participants after successful completion and passed the exam.

Financial

Fee- \$100 per day

-one day standard course \$100 -two day standard course \$200

Rebate: 1) If student becomes an Authorized Wildlife Custodian with-in one year 100 % fee rebated.
2) If student become a Foster Care or Volunteer at a Wildlife Rehab Center for 1 year 50% rebate. Must register completion of course with Ontario Wildlife Rescue.

Expenses: Organizing instructor receives \$50.00 per day per registered student.

Instructor prepares training manual and runs the course.

Certificates: - Students name, date, course name, instructors name
-8 ½ x 11 borders, script type

Courses: - 1) How to look after injured and orphaned
- Squirrels, Skunks, Raccoons, Rabbits, Song Birds, Water Birds
2) How to manage a Wildlife Rehabbing Center
3) Wildlife Rehabbers Course and exam.
